Allotments Access Road

Byfleet Junior School are going through planning for an extension project. As part of this access for the construction work is being proposed through leisure lane, via Stoop Court entrance to the back of the school. If all goes ahead, there will be 8 months of work starting in October, assuming planning permission is granted in July.

I have been assured that:

- the access is temporary access for the duration of the construction;
- construction traffic will not be permitted to be stationary in Camphill Lane or Leisure Lane;
- construction traffic will not be permitted between 08:30-09:30, midday and 15:00 – 16:00 on weekdays;
- due to the expansion additional parking in West Byfleet will be considered.
